Conducted by the Equestrian Australia (Victorian Branch Inc) Dressage Sub-Committee, Dressage with the Stars Committee in accordance with Dressage Competition Rules, effective 1 January 2011 and subsequent amendments (Section 5 Young Horse –and any special conditions listed in this schedule).

- Competition 1:** **Material Championship for 4 year old Ponies**
Open to ponies born between 1-8-2007 and 31-7-2008
- Competition 2:** **Material Championship for 4 year old Riding Horses**
Open to Horses born between 1-8-2007 and 31-7-2008
- Competition 3:** **5 year old Championship for Ponies**
Open to ponies born between 1-8-2006 and 31-7-2007
- Competition 4:** **5 year old Championship for Riding Horses**
Open to Horses born between 1-8-2006 and 31-7-2007
- Competition 5:** **6 year old Championship for Ponies**
Open to Horses born between 1-8-2005 and 31-7-2006
- Competition 6:** **6 year old Championship for Riding Horses**
Open to Horses born between 1-8-2005 and 31-7-2006

Prizes:

- 1st Place Rosette plus the following:
 Owner of the winning horse: Voucher for imported semen (pony prizes TBA)
 Rider: Prize
 Breeder: Prize
- 2nd - 6th Rosette and prize
- 7th - 10th Rosette

Special Trophies:

The Esther Bellis Trophy, donated by The Horse Magazine, will go to the All Round Young Horse Champion. Awarded to the overall best performed horse AYDH and JWTS combined. The horse may have a different rider for each discipline.

Jill Cobcroft Trophy \$2000 donated to the Young Dressage Pony Champion of Champions.

Entry Fee:

\$115 (Inc GST) per horse per competition

This includes two passes with seating in the Riders Gallery for the entire weekend and one copy of the souvenir program.

Rules:

It is the responsibility of the rider to know the rules under which they compete. The 2012 EA Dressage rules can be found at the following link: www.equestrian.org.au and the FEI rules at www.fei.org. Relevant tests can also be found on these websites.

Competition 1 & 2 - Material Championship for 4 Year Old Ponies and Horses

Procedure:

- The Material Class is open to horses and ponies born between 1/8/2007 and 31/7/2008 and is conducted as follows:
 - the test will be the EA 4 Year Old Material Test and will be commanded, consisting of ONE ROUND ONLY
 - horses will enter the arena in groups of 3 under the direction of a caller
 - judges will award a mark out of 10 for walk, trot, canter and general impression as a dressage horse

- horses will then be unsaddled outside the arena and then as directed by the steward, be re presented individually to the judges' in-hand on the centre line at X where they will be required to stand up, walk directly away from, and back towards the judges in a straight line
- horses will be awarded a mark out of 10 for conformation
- the placings are decided by the total score accumulated from the ridden and led sections
- the top 3 horses will be ridden by a guest rider, whose score out of 10 will be added to the other scores to decide the top 3 places
- each group will be allocated approximately 15 (20) minutes
- where possible there will be commentary after each group

Competitions 3, 4, 5 and 6

AYDH and Pony 5 & 6 year old Championship Procedure

First Round:

- to be ridden two horses at a time in the arena
- tests will be EA approved National YH commanded test for 5 & 6 year olds effective 1/1/11 amended 1/4/11

Second Round:

- to be ridden one horse at a time
 - the top ten placings (including equals) from the first round will go forward into the second round, provided they have attained a score of no less than 6.5 (65%) in the first round
 - tests to be ridden are:
 Competition 3 & 4: FEI Dressage Test for 5 year olds – Final (Edition 2004, updated 2009)
 Competition 5 & 6: FEI Dressage Test for 6 year olds – Final (Edition 2004, updated 2009)
 - the mark from the first round will **not** carry forward to the second round
 - the mark from the second round will determine the final placings with the top 3 horses progressing to the third round
- **Please note tests can be downloaded from the website www.fei.org or www.equestrian.org.au*

Third Round:

- the top 3 horses in each age group to be ridden by Emile Faurie. Their scores out of 10 will be added to the other scores of the judging panel to decide the top 3 places
- the top 3 ponies in each age group will be ridden by a guest rider in front of a panel of judges to decide the top 3 places

Champion of Champions Prize:

The following will apply for the Champion of Champions prize:

- There will be an exhibition of the age group winners in front of the judging panel who will decide the overall champion of champions

Consolation Final

Horses and ponies that are not eligible to compete in the second round of their respective age groups will be eligible to compete in the Consolation Final providing they have scored at least 6.0 (60%) in the first round.

- Four Year Olds will ride the current FEI Dressage Test for 4 Year Olds
- Five Year Olds will ride the current FEI Dressage Test for 5Year Olds
- Six Year Olds will ride the current FEI Dressage Test for 6 Year Olds
- Rosettes will be awarded to 6th place
- Competitors must nominate their intention to compete in the consolation final within two hours of final results being posted for the first rounds by completing a nomination form and handing into the secretary's office. Reminders will be announced over the PA system at the event.

Eligibility for the Australian Young Dressage Horse Championships:

- Ponies - 4, 5 and 6 Year old ponies must have qualified by achieving at least 6.0 (60%) at a **Young Pony Qualifying Competition** as per rule 5.4.2.
- Horses - 4, 5 and 6 Year old horses must have qualified by achieving at least 6.5 (65%) at a **Young Horse Qualifying Competition** as per rule 5.4.2.
- Competitors are to submit on the entry form **two performances** in the above-mentioned competitions for eligibility as detailed above. If performances are at events with 2 rounds, the entry form must state in which round the score was achieved
- Horses/Ponies may qualify with one performance, however, preference will be given to horses who have two performances
- to verify the performance, a copy of the test paper or result sheet **must** be submitted with the entry
- competitors will be ranked from the highest average of the two performances to the lowest
- the competitions will be limited to 36 horses from each age group
- a ballot will take place of the highest ranked horses to determine the order of starting
- a reserve list of 15 horses in ranking order will be established
- in special circumstances, the OC can request permission from the ADC to increase the number of entries to the final
- imported horses that only have international qualifications may be accepted, provided proof of appropriate qualification in one or more overseas YH competitions accompanies the entry
- horses may begin to qualify for the 2012 YDH Australian Championships from the 1st August 2011 until the close of entries of the Australian YDH Championships (8th February 2012)

General Conditions:

- Competitions are conducted under EA rules
- All horses must be EA registered and hold a current Dressage Performance Card
- Horses must exceed 149cm with shoes or 148cm without shoes and ponies must not exceed 149cm with shoes or 148cm without shoes
- The birth dates for all horses will be as of 1st August
- Competitions are official but do not attract grading points
- All riders and horse owners must be current financial members of EA
- Riders of horses are eligible from the start of the year they turn 12 years of age. Riders of ponies from the start of the year in which they turn 10 years of age
- The same judges will not necessarily officiate in all rounds
- Horses will be judged on walk, trot, canter, rideability and overall impression as a future dressage horse, including standard of training on the basis of the Training Scale
- The organising committee reserves the right to alter any competition/group sizes dependent upon entries.

Dress and Saddlery:

- Safety helmets are to be worn in the 4 year old competitions
- A top hat or bowler may be worn in the 5 and 6 year old competitions, by riders 18 years and over
- A whip is permitted to be carried in the 4 year old age group at the Australian Championship
- A whip is **not** permitted to be carried in the 5 and 6 year old competitions at the Australian Championships. However, the use of one whip, with a total maximum length of 120cm, in the practice area is allowed. The whip must be dropped before entering the space around the competition arena or the rider will entail a penalty of 0.1 points from the total score
- Horses are to be ridden in a snaffle bridle and the bit must be a minimum of 14mm in diameter as defined in Section 2 of the EA Dressage Rule Book
- The Mexican/Crossed noseband is not permitted
- All other dress and saddlery requirements as per Section 2 of the EA Dressage Rule Book

FEI CODE OF CONDUCT FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) requires all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
2. Horses and competitors must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.
5. The FEI urges all those involved in equestrian sport to attain the highest possible levels of education in their areas of expertise relevant to the care and management of the competition horse.

Conditions

The CDI-W will be conducted in strict accordance with the current edition (including amendments) of: *FEI General Regulations; FEI Veterinary Regulations; FEI Dressage Rules; and FEI Rules for World Cup Dressage.*

The **Grand Prix** and **Grand Prix Freestyle** will be conducted under the rules set for a CDI-W. The Grand Prix serves as the qualifying competition for the Grand Prix Freestyle. The Grand Prix Freestyle will be limited to a maximum of 15. Participation will be determined by the results in the Grand Prix. Horses must earn a minimum score of 58% in the qualifying GP test to be eligible for the Freestyle

- Horses must be **at least 8 years of age for Grand Prix** level and have a height at the withers exceeding 149 cm including shoes
- **CDI-W is open to riders** from the year in which they reach their **16th birthday**
- **Riders** may participate under the **jurisdiction of the country of which the rider holds their passport**
- Riders must take part in both the Grand Prix and Grand Prix Freestyle to be able to obtain BCM Rider Ranking points
- To be considered for the Pacific League Final, competitors must take part in at least two CDI-Ws.
- **Riders** may ride more than one horse in the Freestyle
- **Once entered**, failure to start in the Freestyle to Music for reasons other than illness of horse or rider (in which case the move up system applies) results in the rider **losing his/her Grand Prix classification**
- Riders should be aware that the FEI considers any withdrawals without a valid excuse after the definite entry date as serious
- All horses entered in the CDI-W are subjected to a Fitness Inspection
- Note the following condition will apply: "All horses entered for a CDI-W whether at home or in foreign countries, must have an official FEI Passport, or National Passport approved by the FEI, as a means of identification and to establish ownership". (Gen. Regs. 2011 Art. 137). **EA Horse I.D. documents** are available from the EA National Office. Riders must ensure that they have the appropriate documents on arrival. Enquiries EA 02 8762 7777.

- All riders and horses participating in FEI events (at this event the CDI-W) **must be registered on the FEI database**. Registrations must be renewed each calendar year. EA collects the charges on behalf of the FEI. Registration forms are available on the EA web site. www.equestrian.org.au or contact the National Office. Please note that this registration is required even if the horse has an FEI Passport or EA National Identification Document.
- **Advertising and Publicity on competitors and horses** (Gen. Regs. Art. 135.1-2) the competitors are authorised to carry the logo of their personal sponsor on the saddle cloth in accordance with Art. 135.1-2. **Riders** with privately organised sponsorship may display a "logo" of their sponsor on their saddlecloth. The area covered by this logo **may not exceed 200 sq. cm. A sponsor's label on jackets must not exceed 80 sq. cm at the height of breast pockets**. Please note that if more than one sponsor logo is placed on the saddlecloth, **the area covered by all logos may not exceed 200 sq. cm as above**. The Chief Steward will check that the advertising and publicity on competitors and horses complies with Article 135 of the 2011 General Regulations
- **CDI-W Whips: Refer to Article 428.3, 430.6.2 & 430.7.6**. A whip with a total maximum length of 1.20m in the practice arena is allowed. The whip must be dropped before entering the space around the competition arena or the athlete will be penalised by 2 marks from each judge. Carrying a whip into the arena will also entail a 2 mark penalty from each judge. Carrying a whip longer than 3 movements will entail elimination.
- **The draw for the CDI-W Grand Prix** (in groups of 5) shall be in reverse order of the World Dressage Ranking List. Riders who are not listed on the WDRL shall be drawn first.
- **The draw for the CDI-W Grand Prix Freestyle** shall be in reverse order of placing in the Grand Prix (in groups of 5- i.e. a draw first within the group of athletes placed 11th -15th, then within the group placed 6th - 10th, and the last group of athletes placed 1st – 5th i.e. the best athlete/horse combination starts last). (Art. 425.5)
- **CDI-W competitors** please note the following closing dates: **Definite entries: 8th Feb 2012**. Unless we receive written notification from competitors beforehand, we will assume entries for the CDI-W are **confirmed as definite by the 8th Feb 2012**

Eligibility:

- Performances gained between 9th February 2011 and 8th February 2012
- Horses must have a performance of 60% or above at the respective competition level to be eligible
- A qualifying score of 58% or more in the Grand Prix is required to compete in the Grand Prix Freestyle, and top 15 horses will go into the freestyle
- Horses that do not reach the 58% will receive a refund for the Freestyle entry
- Horses accepted on performances as per National Championships – i.e. based on the average percentage of the 3 highest performances during the previous 12 months. Three performances accepted ahead of those who submit one or two performances. Only one HC score is allowed

- A person may compete as a Young Rider from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reached the age of 16 until the end of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 21
- Horses must be appropriately registered with EA and be at least 7 years of age and eligible under EA rules to compete at the level of the competition — refer to rule 1.14
- All riders and horse owners must be current financial members of the EA
- All horses and riders must also be registered with the FEI to comply with the FEI rules - details on EA National website.
- All horses must exceed 149cm with shoes and hold a current Dressage Performance Card.
- Horses must be able to be identified from any of the following; their EA Registration Papers, a validated National Identification Document or a validated FEI Passport

Eligibility:

- Young rider/horse combinations that have obtained a percentage of 60% in an Official Prix St Georges or Young Rider Prix St Georges at an EA event in the 12 months preceding the CDIY are eligible to enter
- A qualifying score of 58% or more in the Individual test is required to compete in the YR Freestyle. Horses that do not achieve the 58% will receive a refund for the freestyle entry amount
- Horses accepted on performances as per National Championships – i.e. based on the average percentage of the 3 highest performances during the previous 12 months. Three performances accepted ahead of those who submit one or two performances. Only one HC score is allowed

OTHER INFORMATION

Stabling:

- All stabling requirements must be booked on the entry form only.
 - Unfortunately due to restrictions on stabling this year, we are unable to offer stables as tack rooms.
 - Stables will be allocated in the following order of preference:
 - **1. Stallions**
 - **2. CDI-W horses**
 - **3. Interstate horses**
 - **4. FEI horses**
 - **5. Victorian horses**
 - Due to the large number of stallions that are entered for this event there will be stallions placed in stable blocks (with top doors) other than "F" barn (Cobblestone stables). If you have entered a stallion and it cannot have geldings stabled alongside or at the back please advise us of this on your stabling form in the request area. This will help us avoid having issues upon arrival.
- Note: If stable bookings exceed availability of stables, then stabling allocation will be based on the above, with horses ranked from most nights booked to least nights booked. I.e. A stallion booked for one night will be allocated a stable, whereas a Victorian gelding/mare booked for one night will be placed on the waiting list. Competitors will then be advised when a stable becomes available
- Competitors must use the stable allocated by the Organising Committee for their horse/s
 - Any obviously empty stables are not to be used as feed/tack rooms or for any horse for which stabling has not been booked
 - Yards are available free of charge

7. Stallions must at all times be in the control of a person aged seventeen years or more, when led or ridden
8. Horses are not permitted within/upon the quadrangle (between the barn & Indoor 1)
9. Horses are not permitted near pedestrian door ways
10. Bicycles are not permitted in the Indoor Arenas or any stable block. Approved helmets must be worn at all times.
11. Bicycles are not permitted near doors designated as public entrances or exits
12. Motor Cyclist riders must wear approved safety helmets and hold the appropriate licence
13. Speed limits must be adhered to at all times, the speed limit at WPNEC is 10km p/h
14. Power leads must not be on the ground or over roadways
15. Construction of portable/tape yards is **prohibited**
16. Alcohol must not be consumed in the Indoor Arenas, unless purchased from the licensed bar located in Indoor Arena No 1
