A commentary sheet must be filled out and we advise owners/riders be available to either discuss their stallion with the commentator prior or have someone on hand during to assist. The stallion show will run like they do in Europe we will have two horses in the ring at once. Stallions must be able to cope with this situation and be presented appropriately.

Arena familiarisation will be on Wednesday 2pm-4pm only NO JUMPING

Judging of Section 4-6 are by a panel of three- Greg Best (International), Michelle Strap (AUS) and Jeff Bloomfield (AUS). Course Designer- Gavin Chester (AUS)

SCORING Young Horse Classes (Section A,B and C only)

ALL JUMPING CLASSES ARE RUN UNDER EA JUMPING RULES

- Horses will be judged on jumping technique, scope over fences and rideability between fences ie correct number of strides between related distances, being on the bit, changes etc.
- **Penalties:** each rail down deduct 0.5
1st refusal deduct 1.0 2nd refusal deduct 2.0 3rd refusal elimination
- **Third Round:** The number of horses progressing to Saturday's 3rd round will be limited to the top 10 place getters qualified from round 1 (Thursday) and round 2 (Friday).

Overall placegetters in each Age Group

- Points over the three judged competitions will be added together (highest score is the winner).
In case of equal points – the placing in the 2nd round will determine the winner.
Prize: Total value of goods or money- \$1120 (\$500, \$250, \$150, \$100, \$60 \$60) TBC
Rosettes to 6th in the overall placings of each age group

The Champion of Champions will be chosen from the winners of each age group.

- **Champion of Age Group will receive a trophy rug.**
- Guest rider Jeff Bloomfield will ride the winner of each age group (Section A,B,C) as an exhibition in front of the rest of the panel of judges and their final selection will be named the champion of champions.
- Sky High Perpetual Trophy donated by Jaybee Farm will be awarded to Champion of Champions.

The Esther Bellis Trophy donated by The Horse Magazine will be awarded to the overall best performed horse AYDH and JWTS combined. The horse may have a different rider for each discipline.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- All horses must be registered with the EV and exceed 14.2hh
- Young Horse Classes are official but do not attract grading points
- All riders and horse owners must be current financial members of the EV.
- Any rider found in breach of EV or FEI rules will face elimination from the competition on all horses and will forfeit any prize money.

The organizing committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry; to alter or amend any of the conditions, regulations or any aspects of the Event, to cancel any class without assigning reasons, or to seed the order of starting.



FEI CODE OF CONDUCT FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) requires all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
2. Horses and competitors must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.
5. The FEI urges all those involved in equestrian sport to attain the highest possible levels of education in their areas of expertise relevant to the care and management of the competition horse.

OTHER INFORMATION

Stabling:

- All stabling requirements must be booked on the entry form only.
- Unfortunately due to restrictions on stabling this year, we are unable to offer stables as tack rooms.
- Stables will be allocated in the following order of preference:
 - **1. Stallions**
 - **2. CDI –W Horses**
 - **3. Interstate Horses**
 - **4. FEI Horses**
 - **5. Victorian Horses**
- Due to the large amount of stallions that are entered for this event there will be stallions placed in stable blocks (with top doors) other than “F” barn (Cobblestone stables). If you have entered a stallion and it is quiet enough to have geldings alongside or at the back of it please advise us of this on your stabling form in the request area. This will help us avoid having to have empty stables next to stallions
- Note: If stable bookings exceed availability of stables, then stabling allocation will be based on the above, with horses ranked from most nights booked to least nights booked. i.e. A stallion booked for one night will be allocated a stable, whereas a Victorian gelding/mare booked for one night will be placed on the waiting list. Competitors will then be advised when a stable becomes available
- Competitors must use the stable allocated by the Organising Committee for their horse/s
- Any obviously empty stables are not to be used as feed/tack rooms or for any horse for which stabling has not been booked
- Yards are available free of charge

Horse Feed & Bedding:

Horse feed and bedding will be the responsibility of the competitor and can be purchased through the Werribee Park National Equestrian Centre 03 9741 7672 or admin@wpnec.com.au. It is preferred that all bedding is to be booked prior to arrival at WPNEC. There will be no bedding orders taken by email/fax or phone after 3pm on the day prior to event. Please visit the WPNEC website for current pricing.

Exercising of Horses/Bridle Numbers:

- Two bridle numbers (as per listed competition number in program/draw) must be worn, one on each side of the horse (either on bridle or saddle cloth) at all times whenever the horse is out of the stable. Riders will need to supply their own numbers
- Specific times will be allocated for arena familiarisation. See provisional timetable for details
- The Organising Committee ask that stallion disks be worn at all times

Swabbing:

- Random swabbing will take place throughout the event.
- Competitors whose horses have been selected for sampling will be instructed by an official to present their horse immediately to the box prepared for the purpose, and must comply with such official's instructions. A steward will accompany the horse and rider to the swabbing box

Liability:

- Riders and/or owners whose entries have been accepted will undertake to indemnify the Organizing Body against all claims, losses, suits, and damages made against or suffered by the Organizing Body by reason of any negligent act or omission on the part of any rider, trainer or attendant whilst he is attending, riding or otherwise handling a horse and agrees that act or omission on the part of such rider or attendant found in any action against the Organizing Body to be negligent, shall be deemed to have been negligent for the purpose of any claim under this indemnity

- Late or incomplete entries will not be accepted
- Any horse not accepted on reserve list will receive a full refund.
- Any horse accepted on the reserve list will be charged the compulsory administration fee.
- **Scratchings/Withdrawals** - 50% of entry fee (excluding administration fee) will be refunded on receipt of a medical or veterinary certificate, submitted to Jumping Event Secretary, PO Box 616, Werribee, VIC 3030 **within 3 days of the event.**
- Stable & camping fees will be refunded in full upon presentation of medical or veterinary certificate **within 3 days of the event**

Dressage Masterclass with Greg Best

Riders will be selected for "Preparing for the Equine Athlete" on Thursday night as well as other combinations who will be involved with the Saddleworld Dressage Masterclass on Saturday. This is a unique opportunity for a very limited number of riders to train with Greg Best.

The information set out within this document *must* be included in the Prize Schedule, Competitor Information and/or Official Program for your event/s. This information must be signed by event Organiser prior to an event, and adhered to at all times.

1. Werribee Park National Equestrian Centre Committee of Management considers it a **privilege** that you are allowed to bring your dog to this venue. We insist you **keep your dog under effective control** at all times.
2. Approved Safety Helmets must be worn at all times when riding
3. Cross Country obstacles must not be jumped/used unless a non riding level one coach is present.
4. Riding of horses bareback is **prohibited**
5. Riding of rugged and/or unbridled horses is **prohibited**
6. Any person may lead a maximum of two horses while mounted
7. Stallions must at all times be in the control of a person aged seventeen years or more, when led or ridden
8. Horses are not permitted within/upon the quadrangle (between the barn & Indoor 1)
9. Horses are not permitted near pedestrian door ways
10. Bicycles are not permitted in the Indoor Arenas or any stable block. Approved helmets must be worn at all times.
11. Bicycles are not permitted near doors designated as public entrances or exits
12. Motor Cyclist riders must wear approved safety helmets and hold the appropriate licence
13. Speed limits must be adhered to at all times, the speed limit at WPNEC is 10km p/h
14. Power leads must not be on the ground or over roadways
15. Construction of portable/tape yards is **prohibited**
16. Alcohol must not be consumed in the Indoor Arenas, unless purchased from the licensed bar located in Indoor Arena No1
